UNDERTAKINGS REGISTERED:

Baker's Brook Rock Quarry Expansion Proponent: Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Ltd.

The proponent is proposing to develop a 14.1-hectare rock quarry adjacent to their existing quarry, located near Route 440 within the City of Corner Brook. The site is accessible via a 1.2 kilometre gravel road extending from Route 440. Site development will involve vegetation clearing, grubbing and stockpiling of organics. Quarry operations will include drilling, blasting, ripping, crushing and screening.

The undertaking was registered on October 28, 2019; the deadline for public comments is December 5, 2019; and the Minister's decision is due by December 12, 2019.

Hampden Residential Property #2 Proponent: Mr. Kyle Osmond

The proponent proposes to construct a residential dwelling at 22 Elms Place in the Town of Hampden, off Route 421. The dwelling will be located on a 0.186-hectare lot approximately 130 metres from the Hampden River. Development will consist of land clearing and levelling, installation of water and sewer systems, landscaping and building
