Construction of cottage access road to cottage on Moosehead Lake Site #315.

The Undertaken:

It is proposed that a .8 km road be constructed from an existing roadway that comes off of the Labrador Highway. The proposed road will branch off the existing road and go through a lightly wooded area to my cabin site #315 as highlighted on the map.

Geographical Location:

On the Labrador Highway at Moosehead Lake, approximately 15 kilometers from Labrador City to the exit.

Physical Features:

The area is fairly level and lightly wooded. The area would have to be cleared for the proposed roadway. The road would be constructed using the natural elevation of the landscape. The road will be ditched if required and if a culvert is required, it will be installed. A personal survey of the area indicated mostly moss over sand.

Construction:

Construction of this project will start as soon as I receive the OK from your department. The construction will take about 2 to 3 days once I have site prepared, ie. the right of way cleared.

A D6 or equivalent will be used for the construction along with trucks and excavator if required.

Operation:

The cost of construction and maintenance of road will be the responsibility of the proponent.

There will be no sources of pollutants other than that of regular exhaust emissions and road dust.

Project Schedule:

I'm requesting the earliest possible approval so that I can have this project completed this coming summer.


Funding:
