**Operational Considerations:**

Harvest System: Mechanical

Terrain Conditions: Hilly and rolling terrain, dry well drained sandy soil  
The merchantable forest is broken by areas of scs, sb and bog

**Other Considerations:**

- Wildlife - Pine Marten habitat study, connectivity working group with Gross Morne National Park, regular meetings with DNR to review annual operating plans.
- Water - Regulatory 20 meter buffers, 100 meter buffers on main stem of salmon rivers, 30 meter no grub zones, guidelines for working inside protected watersheds.
- Outfitters- Harvest and road construction scheduling to avoid conflicts, all outfitting locations plotted on CBPP harvest maps for planning purposes.
- Ecotourism - Meetings with snowmobile tour operators. Public access to all company built roads.
- Sawmills- Sawlog exchange agreement will continue.  
Commercial and domestic hardwood permits available for CBPP limits.
- Recreation - Public access to all company built roads, regular meetings with local snowmobile clubs. Approval process for cottage development on CBPP limits.
- Mining - Approval process to allow mining and quarry activities on CBPP limits.
