

Figure 1. Map showing the general area in which trial spray blocks to be treated with Abietiv (NeabNPV – *Neodiprion abietis* nucleopolyhedovirus) will be established. The orange line indicates the approximate location of the northeast boundary of the balsam fir sawfly infestation as determined from egg counts carried out by the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Natural Resources. The black arrow indicates the direction of movement of the infestation. Spray blocks will be established within the areas limited by the yellow boxes based on balsam fir sawfly egg surveys, restrictions as dictated by the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Environment and the Pest Management Regulatory Agency (Health Canada) and accessibility. The total area to be sprayed will not exceed 5,000 hectares.
