

is approximately 24 long X 6' wide. The other 6 approximately 10long X6' wide. Construction will start this fall the project should take 2 years to complete using ATV, Chainsaw, and hand-held tools to construct. The trail will be built by family members. Also, no pesticides or herbicides will be used to construct or maintain the trail (manual/ by hand vegetation control where nessary) Trail will travel mostly thought barrens 80% 10% and 10% marsh lands.

- IV. Operations: This ATV trail will provide all year around access to the remote cabin.
- V. Occupations: The trail in question would be used by the proponent
- VI. Project Related Documents: The proponent will require a crown land. Permit(File Ref No. 2023625, application No. 126921) Permission to occupy ATV trail.

Approval of The undertaking: The land officer of the Department of Government Service and land's Central Region has advised that their department, and the Department of Mines and Energy, Forestry, Division, Agriculture Division, Historic Resources, Division Dept. works. Services and Transportation have already approved this project and are awaiting the Department of Environment Assessment Divisions approval.

Schedule: Once approval is received for the ATV trail, the proponent plans to start as soon as possible December, 2005 providing there is no snow in the country. It is desired by the proponent to be able to access their cabin next fall.

Funding: The total cost of developing this ATV trail will be paid by the proponent.
