The upgrading of an existing 3.5 Km trail adjoining the St. Lawrence Area Trail Association trail.

THE UNDERTAKING:

- (i) Nature of the Undertaking:

The upgrading of an existing 3.5 Km trail (green on the attached map).

- (ii) Purpose / Rational Need for the undertaking:

The St. Lawrence Area Trail Association (SLATA) is currently upgrading a recreational trail Number (LTO) E101271 to within 3.5 Km of my existing cabin (E117561). Since a marked trail from the SLATA trail to the cabin already exists, and has done so for a number of years, I am requesting Crown title. This environmental application is part of the process.

DESCRIPTION OF THE UNDERTAKING:

- (i) Geographic Location:

Please see the attached map (1:50,000 - Marystown - 1M/3). The area is north of the Town of St. Lawrence and the trail runs from Tilt Hill via Rocky Ridge Pond to Sharp Peak.

(ii) Physical Features:

The trail, as indicated on the map provided, will be approximately 3.5 Km in length and will be constructed to a maximum width of 4 m.

(iii) Construction:

The trail is to be built in such a way as to protect the wetlands, streams and wildlife but provide maximum comfort and safety to the users. All major streams will be bridged using untreated timber and where necessary bogland will be corduroyed. All construction will be by manual labour.

Work on the trail will be conducted during the winter months when it can be legally accessed. When the SLATA trail advances to join the two trails access will be year-round.

(iv) Operation:

The trail will provide orderly access by ATV and snowmobiles for recreational riders to an existing cabin.

(v) Occupants:

The trail will be used by the Proponent.

(vi) Project-Related Documents:

Application for a licence to occupy (9 February, 2007) number 130302, file reference 1025711.

It is understood the proponent will require permission for two stream crossings.

The proponent will require (approval pending) a Crown title for the section of trail. Approval for the trail has been received in principle from the St. Lawrence Town Council (the Mayor of St. Lawrence supported the original application for the licence to occupy). The application is also supported by the St. Lawrence Area Trail Association of which I am a member.

SCHEDULE:

The schedule of work proposed will commence when all necessary permits are in place and will be completed once the SLATA trail reaches the proposed trail junction.

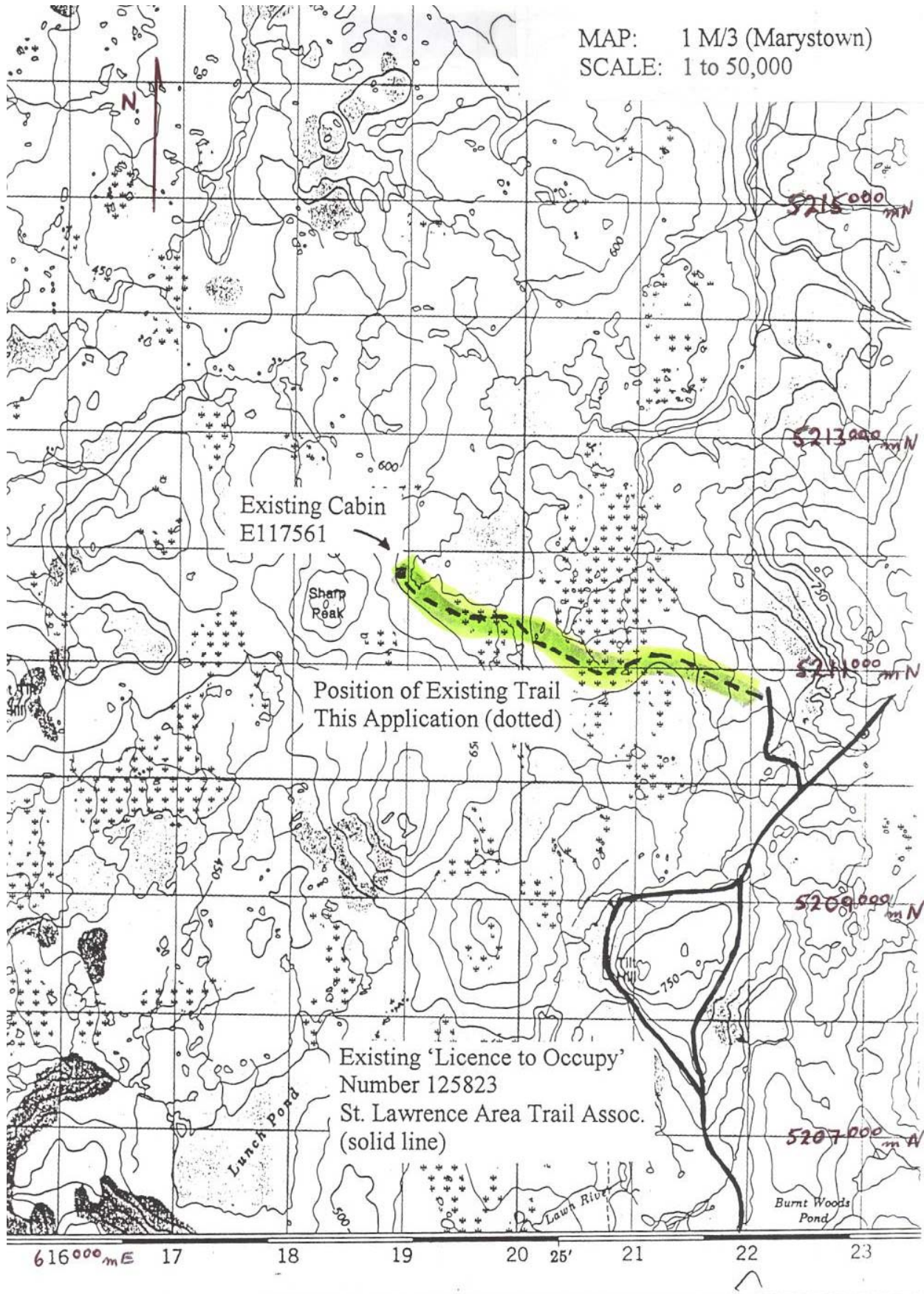
FUNDING:

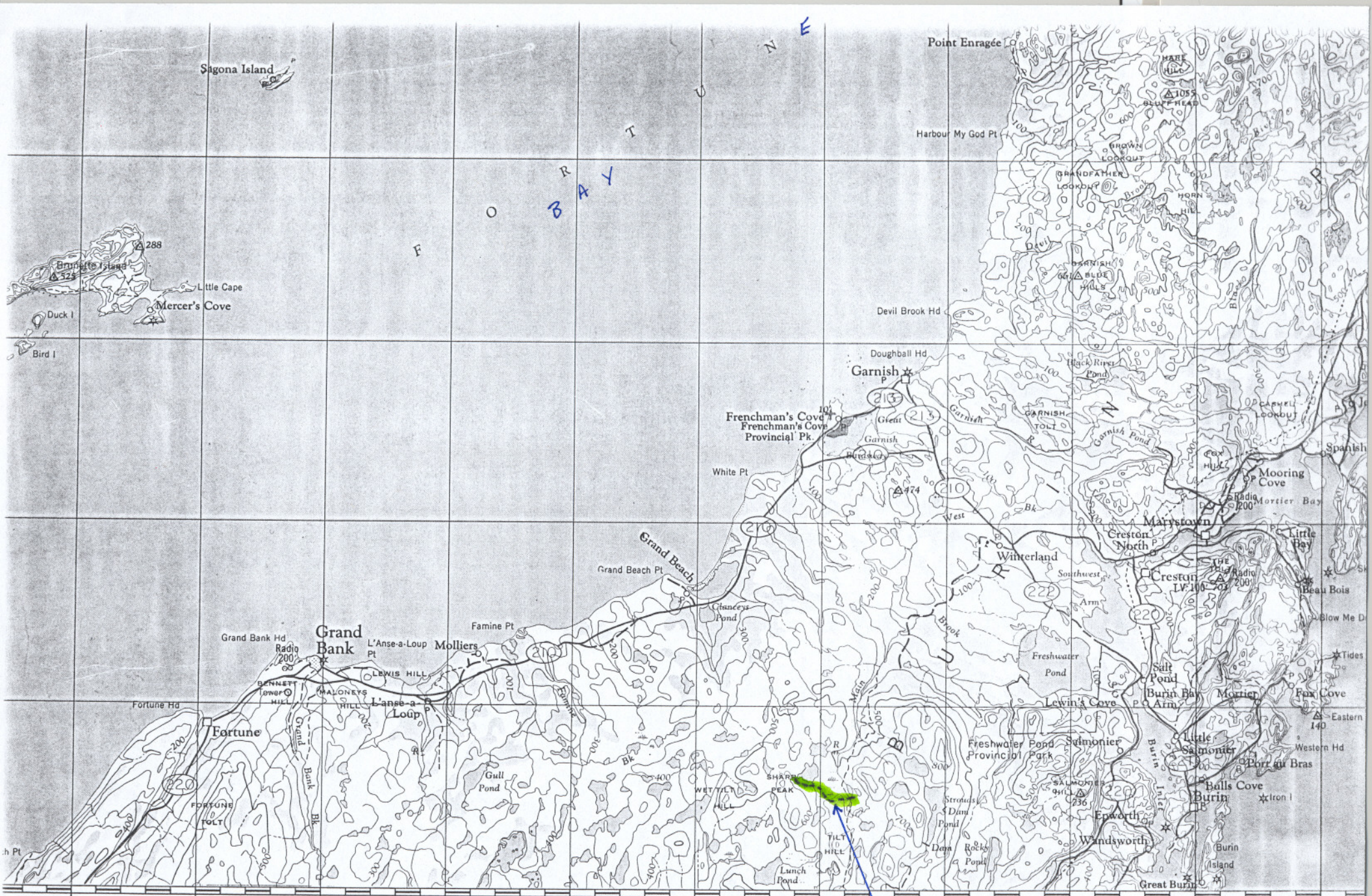
The total cost of constructing this ATV/snowmobile trail will be paid by the proponent.


To whom it may concern,
