### The Undertaking:

The proponents plan to develop a 2 kilometre Snowmobile Trail in the Humber Village area of Western Newfoundland. The trail is intended to provide a safe access, out of the Village, to the groomed trail system managed by The Newfoundland And Labrador Snowmobile Federation. It will commence/exit the Village from Pine Street and travel westward on the former COTC cable line to the "Butler Property" for an approximate 420 meters. It will then turn northward on a right-of-way between the "Butler and Sharpe" property and on to the back country for a further distance of approximately 1.5 kilometres.
