### THE UNDERTAKING

(1) Nature of Undertaking:

ATV Trail

(2) Purpose/ Rationale/Need for the Undertaking:

To construct an ATV trail to access remote cabin, for recreational use for myself. A direct route from Musgrave Hr. To the cabin with no sides trails.

### DESCRIPTION OF THE UNDERTAKING

### (1) Geographical Location:

### -description of the proposed site:

to leave Musgrave Hr. and travel 7kms to remote cabin. There are two small brooks to cross but appropriate bridging using natural resources will be done. There will be no impact on the flow of the brooks. There is some scrub and treed areas. Also a little marsh area which will be codroyed using natural resources.

### -major physical features of the undertaking:

no other cabins in the area.

### -area to be affected by the undertaking:

the trail will traverse through some wooded area, mostly scrub and a little marsh area which will be codroyed. No excavation required.

### -a description of physical and biological environment:

the terrain consists of some wooded area, scrub, marsh land that will be codroyed and two small brooks which will be bridged using natural resources. The trail will not interfere with the natural habitat of wildlife of fish life.

### - approximate total construction period:

unknown, the 7km trail will be done gradually.

# - proposed date of first physical construction activity on site:

spring of 2011 if application approved.

### - potential sources of pollutants during the construction period:

very little pollutants as to the fact that only a chain saw, axe, and hammer will be used.

### -potential causes of resource conflicts:

no conflict use. There are no industrial operations in the area.

### - description of the operation:

the trail is for recreational use only for access to my remote cabin at Jabes Pond. The trail can only be used by ski-doo as of now. No ponds are crossed. The trail construction will allow access by ATV so I can

access my cabin year round.

minimal pollution, the trail is for me to access my remote cabin. Personal use only.

### - potential causes of resource conflicts

There are no industrial activities in this area.

the trail will be constructed by me, with help from my father. Work to be carried out gradually as the trail undertaking is about 7kms long.


