Avalon

All Crown Land within the following area: Commencing at a point at the mouth of the Come-by-Chance River; thence following the Come-by Chance River in a generally Northerly direction to its intersection with the Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro transmission line; thence following the said transmission line in an Easterly direction across the Trans Canada, Route 1, continuing for approximately 8,300 feet (2,529.8 meters) more or less until it intersects another transmission line running a North-South direction; thence following this second transmission line in a generally Southerly direction for 400 feet (121.9 meters) more or less to a point where it intersects a stream; thence following the stream in a generally Northeasterly direction to the mouth of the stream which empties into the salt waters of Bull Arm in Trinity Bay; thence following the coastline in a generally Southeasterly direction to the most Southerly point in Dildo Arm; thence following the coastline in a generally Northeasterly direction to a point known as Grates Point; thence following the coastline in a generally Southerly direction to the most Southerly point in South Arm in Holyrood Bay; thence following the coastline in a generally Northeasterly direction to a point known as Cape St. Francis; then following the coastline in a generally Southerly direction to a point known as Mistaken Point; thence following the coastline in a generally Westerly and Northerly and Southerly direction to a point known as Cape Pine; thence following the coast line in a generally Northerly direction to the most Northerly point of Colinet Harbour; thence following the coastline in a generally Southerly direction to a point known as Cape St. Marys; thence following the coastline in a generally Northerly direction to the point of commencement and including all offshore islands except those in Placentia Bay.
