Schedule: Quarry would be ongoing beginning in the 2012 construction season.

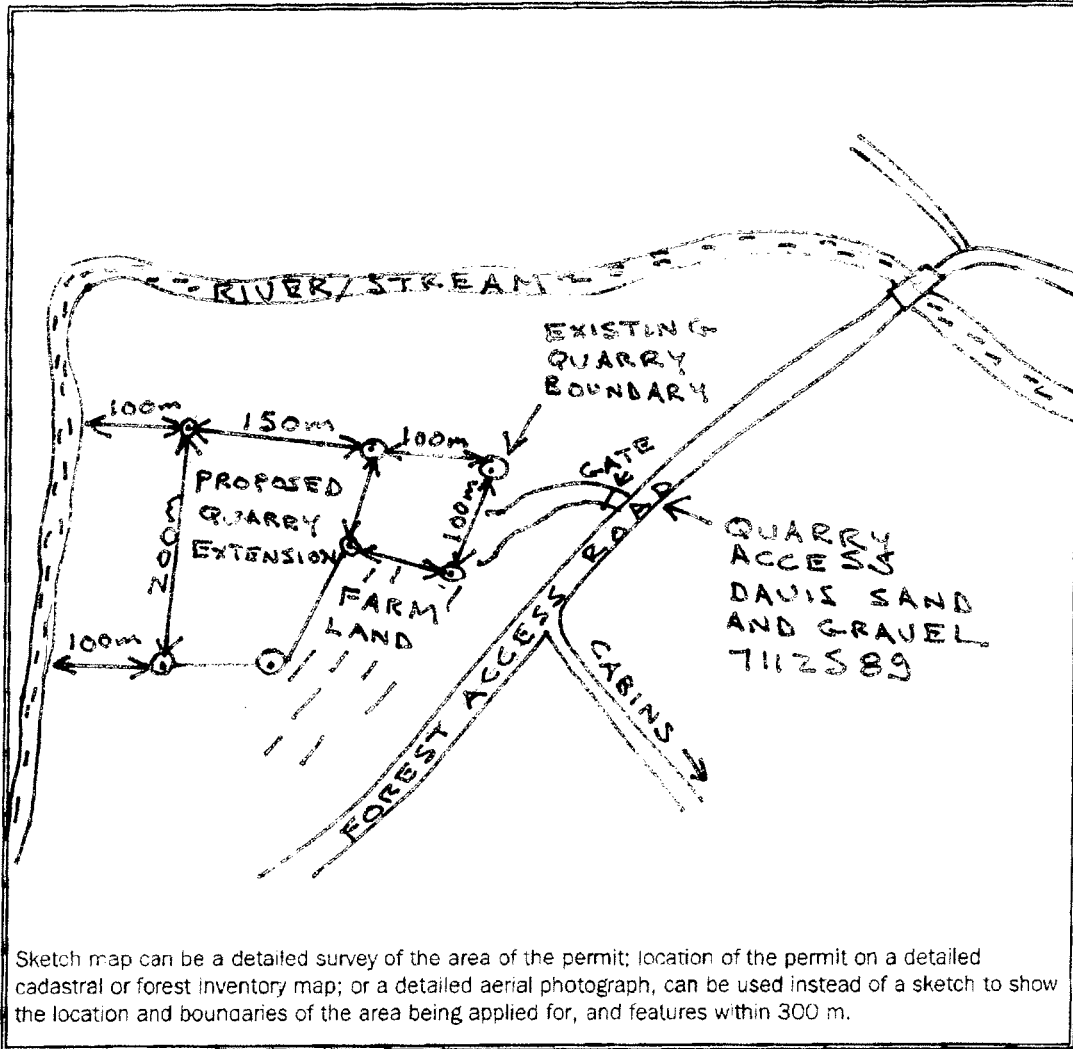
