(i) Nature of Undertaking

Timber harvesting amendment to the Crown Five Year Operating Plan for Forest Management District5 (Zone 3).

(ii) Purpose/Rationale/Need for Undertaking

This undertaking will enable the Forest Services Branch to access approximately 25,000 m3 of timber;

This undertaking is necessary to expand upon the existing commercial harvesting opportunities within the District to compensate for harvesting opportunities no longer available due to an agricultural quarantine within the District.

Description of Undertaking: (i) Geographic Location

The proposed Harvey's Pond amendment area is located in the western/central portion of FMD 5. Overview and operational maps included with the amendment outline the general and exact locations within the planning zone.

Loggers, equipment operators, truckers.



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
Commercial operating permits will be required from the District Forest Management Office prior to harvesting.
