THE UNDERTAKING:

Nature of the Undertaking: Meade's Services and Storage is being created to serve as temporary land storage for collected steel and associated materials and to also act as a storage place for personal heavy equipment.

Purpose: It is the intention to reuse the materials that are typically sent to landfills and dumps and to serve as a designated area to collect these materials and store them in a viable manner.

Rationale: The focus of this undertaking is to collect various disposable and recyclable materials from discarded vehicles and other items. The reason why this undertaking is being set up is to ensure that these materials are dealt with in the proper manner, for example, disposed of properly or recycled/reused when able.

Need: This undertaking will allow for the safe storage of materials that would otherwise be discarded or left behind. This will reduce the amount of car wrecks, steel, aluminums, etc. that is often neglected in backyards, garages, etc.

DESCRIPTION OF THE UNDERTAKING:

Geographical Location: This site is located on the south side of Route 102, Ship Harbour Road, NL which is situated approximately 1.3 km from the community of Fox Harbour, NL. This site was once an operational fill quarry used by the Department of Highways. The site is also bordered on the west boundary by Gordon J. Murphy. The east boundary of the property is estimated to be 800 feet from Ship Harbour Brook. (see enclosed map)

Physical Features: The size of the area to be affected by the undertaking is 100 feet x 100 feet in dimension. The pole line is 75 feet from the northern boundary of the undertaking and 100 feet from the southern boundary of Route 102. There are no foreseen physical or biological environments within the area that would be potentially affected by the undertaking, as all potential sources of pollutants will be removed prior to storage at the site.

Construction: This is not applicable to proposed undertaking.

Operation: Scrap steel material will be delivered to the undertaking site and stored until which time it will be removed by recycling companies for disposal. Pollutants such as antifreeze, motor oil, and gasoline from the scrap automobiles present on site, will be removed prior to storage at the site of the undertaking.

Occupations: This undertaking will not operate as a place of employment; therefore, provisions for employees will not be necessary or applicable in these circumstances.
