**RE: Badger Area Quarry**

Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act, SNL 2002, cE-14.2*. Please be advised that this undertaking is released from further environmental assessment subject to the following conditions:

- Quarry operations can only be conducted on weekdays and only between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and no operations are to occur between June 15 and September 15.
- A 50-metre naturally vegetated buffer must be maintained around all water bodies and wetlands to protect any sensitive habitat.
- The quarry must operate under a Quarry Lease.

Please be advised while access exists to the general quarry area you are required to submit a Crown lands application for access to the actual quarry site. Contact the Central Regional Lands Office in Gander at (709) 256-1400 for additional information.

The Forestry Services Branch of the Department of Natural Resources has advised that the proposed quarry overlaps with a silviculture area containing merchantable timber. Please contact the Bishop's Falls District Office, Telephone 709-258-5334 for additional information.

Although the undertaking, as proposed, is released from further environmental assessment, it is still subject to other legislative requirements. A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. You may also refer to the BizPaL website at [www.bizpal.ca](http://www.bizpal.ca). BizPaL is an online tool that generates a list of permits, licences and authorizations that may be required when starting or expanding a business.
