Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act*, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Upon consideration of the comments received, please be advised that this undertaking is released from further environmental assessment subject to the following condition.


- A Gender Equity and Diversity Plan must be submitted to and approved by the Women's Policy Office prior to the start of the project.

Please be advised, a water use licence is required from the Water Resources Management Division. Contact Dr. Abdel-Zaher Kamal Abdel-Razek, Manager, Water Rights and Investigations Section at (709)729-4795 or aabdelrazek@gov.nl.ca. A waste management plan for special and hazardous waste material to be generated in relation to fibreglass production is required from the Pollution Prevention Division. Contact Ms. Marie Ryan, Senior Environmental Scientist, at (709)729-1810 or ryanm@gov.nl.ca. Also, a development permit is required from the Town of Long Harbour - Mount Arlington Heights.

In addition to the requirements noted above, the project is still subject to other legislative requirements. A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. You may also refer to the BizPaL website at www.bizpal.ca. BizPaL is an online tool that generates a list of permits, licences and authorizations that may be required when starting or expanding a business. You are also encouraged to contact Canada Business Newfoundland and Labrador (CBNL) for any additional information you may need in dealing with various levels of government. CBNL serves as a first point of access to federal and provincial government services, programs and regulatory requirements for business. Please note that you must comply with all relevant legislation and obtain all necessary permits and approvals. You are required to inform this Department of any proposed significant changes to the undertaking.
