Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act*, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Please be advised that this undertaking is **released** from further environmental assessment.

The Pollution Prevention Division of this department advise that all waste material, including the processed organic material (e.g. spent grain), shall be considered prior to disposal, reuse, resale, or recycling. For information on composting, please contact the Pollution Prevention Division at (709) 729-7012.

The Local Governance and Planning Division of this department advise that development, building, and occupancy permits are required from the Port au Port East Town Council prior to commencing development. For further information, please contact the Town of Port au Port East at (709) 648-2731.

The Water Resources Management Division of this Department requires that you apply for and obtain permits under the *Water Resources Act* for a Non-Domestic Well and a water use licence. For further information, please contact the Water Resources Management Division at (709) 729-2539 for information regarding non-domestic wells and (709) 729-2295 for information regarding a water use licence.

The Department of ServiceNL requires that you apply for and obtain approvals regarding electrical, sewage disposal, Fire and Life Safety and a Food Establishment Licence. For further information, please contact Service NL at (709) 637-2229.


The Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment supports Environment and Climate Change Canada's recommendation that in order to avoid nest destruction and to accommodate the breeding season of migratory songbirds and waterfowl, operations should

consider nesting locations between April 15th and August 15th in this region. However, as some species protected under the *Migratory Birds Convention Act* (MBCA) do nest outside of this time period, it is the responsibility of the proponent to ensure that project activities are in compliance with the MCBA and associated regulations. For further information, please contact the Canadian Wildlife Service at (709) 772-2154.

Although the undertaking, as proposed, is released from further environmental assessment, it is still subject to other legislative requirements. A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. Please note that you must comply with all relevant legislation and obtain all necessary permits and approvals. You are required to inform this Department of any proposed significant changes to the undertaking.
