Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act*, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Please be advised that this undertaking is released from further environmental assessment.

The Local Governance and Planning Division of this department advises that if the City of Corner Brook Council is supportive of the proposed undertaking, an amendment to the City's Municipal Plan and/or Development Regulations is necessary for the proposed undertaking to proceed. The City of Corner Brook Council has sole autonomy and authority to make changes to the City's Municipal Plan and Development Regulations. The City Council may be reached at (709) 637-1666.

Please be advised, all waste material, including the processed organic material (e.g. spent grain) shall be considered, prior to disposal, for reuse, resale, and/or recycling. For information on composting, contact Ms. Vicki Ficzero, Environmental Scientist, Pollution Prevention Division, at (709) 729-7012 or vickificzero@gov.nl.ca.

The Department of ServiceNL requires that you apply for and obtain approvals regarding electrical and building accessibility as well as a Food Establishment Licence. For further information, please contact Service NL at (709) 637-2229. You are required to apply to the City of Corner Brook for fire and life safety approvals and access to water and sewer.

Although the undertaking, as proposed, is released from further environmental assessment, it is still subject to other legislative requirements. A detailed summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements.


