RE: PESG Chapel Arm Services Facility – Registration 1924

Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act*, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Please be advised that this undertaking is **released** from further environmental assessment.

The Pollution Prevention Division of this department recommends that you prepare a "Waste Management Plan", which includes solid and waste dangerous goods/hazardous waste, and an "Environmental Contingency Plan". The Waste Management Section is available to assist or review. They also recommend that you follow the guidance document "Best Management Practices for the storage of waste dangerous goods/hazardous waste (WDG/HW) at business sites" for the management of all such wastes. For more information, please contact the Waste Management Section at (709) 729-1810.

The Local Governance and Planning Division of this department advise that a development permit is required from the Town of Chapel Arm prior to commencing development. For further information, please contact the Town of Chapel Arm at (709) 592-2720.

The Water Resources Management Division of this Department requires that you apply for and obtain a water use licence for the use of water from any water source for any water use purpose. If a drilled well is required, you must also apply for and obtain a Permit for Constructing a Non-Domestic Well prior to the start of construction. For further information, please contact the Water Resources Management Division at (709) 729-2295 for permits regarding a water use licence and (709) 729-2539 for regarding a Permit for Constructing a Non-Domestic Well.

The Government Service Centre and the Occupational Health and Safety Division of Service NL also provided advice and requirements. The Government Service Centre requires

you to submit electrical plans and to apply for and obtain permits for each electrical meter. They also require you to apply for Fire and Life Safety (Request for Approval of Plans Form) and Building Accessibility (Application for Building Accessibility Registration Form) review. For further information, please contact the Government Service Centre at (709) 466-4063. The Occupational Health and Safety Division provided regulatory requirements to ensure that activities associated with the operation of a Commercial Services Facility are conducted in compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and its Regulations. This includes the responsibility for ensuring that contractors hired to perform work also comply with this legislation. For further information, please contact the Occupational Health and Safety Division at (709) 729-7475.

Although the undertaking, as proposed, is released from further environmental assessment, it is still subject to other legislative requirements. A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. Please note that you must comply with all relevant legislation and obtain all necessary permits and approvals. You are required to inform this Department of any proposed significant changes to the undertaking.
