The Undertaking:

#### (i) Nature of Undertaking

Amendment to the Crown Five Year Operating Plan for Forest Management District 12 an addition 5430 hectares along with 25 kilometers of forest access road.

## (ii) Purpose/Rationale/Need for Undertaking

This amendment is required to create operational flexibility for commercial harvesters to match market demands. Currently the harvesting of large dimensional timber is out of sync with the

demand for such timber. By opening up this area commercial sawmills in central Newfoundland feel they will be better suited to balance their supply chain. Additionally primary forest access road will also be required

The amendment represents approximately 5430 ha and 150,000 cubic meters of commercial fiber and 25 km of new primary forest access road.

It should be noted that sustainable harvest levels will not be exceeded and will be balance by reducing the harvested levels elsewhere

### Description of Undertaking: (i) Geographic Location

Forest Management District 12 located in the central interior portion of the island. It ranges north to the Gaff Topsail, to the east it is bound by Exploits and Noel Paul River and stretches south to Blizzard Pond

The majority the area inside of Harvesting Block CC12034 is located on Crown Land approximately 22 kms South of the town of Millertown. Access to the general area is via an existing forest access road, locally known as Granite Lake Access Road and Denny's Pond South Access Road. The attached 1:50,000 scale maps identifies the geographic location of the proposed amendment.

#### (iii) Operation

Harvesting

As noted above the proposed addition of Harvest Block CC12034 will provide access

to an additional 150,000 m<sup>3</sup> of harvestable timber South of Victoria River. All timber will be harvested to utilize the maximum amount of fiber. The timber will be felled mechanically and forwarded to roadside by conventional means. Harvesting is expected to be completed during the life of the current 5-Year Forest Management Plan for Forest Management District 12 (2016-20).

#### Road Construction

There will be 25 kilometers of primary forest access road. Upgrading existing road and operation roads will be constructed as needed within this area. Roads will be constructed using excavators and / or bulldozers. All buffer requirements and operations will be carried out in accordance with Environmental the Protection Guidelines for Ecologically Based Forest Resources Management and the Forestry Act. Operations will commence upon approval of the undertaking and will continue until work is complete

## (iv) Occupations

Equipment operators, truckers, loggers, sawmillers and silviculture workers.

# (v) Project Related Documents

Upon approval, this proposal will become part of the Crown's Forest Management Zone 5 Five-Year Operating Plan, January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2020.

Approval of the Undertaking: (i) Commercial harvesting permits from the District 12 (Bishop's Falls) Forest Management Office.
