RE: Mary's Harbour Breakwater

On November 1, 2018, the Mary's Harbour Breakwater project was released from environmental assessment, subject to the condition that an environmental protection plan (EPP) for the project is submitted to and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment prior to the commencement of project construction.

On January 16, 2019, DFO-Small Craft Harbours submitted an EPP for the Mary's Harbour Breakwater project, which was subject to a review by interested government agencies. The EPP was found to be acceptable and is therefore approved.

Please be aware that you must abide by all commitments made in the EPP and that any significant changes will be subject to additional review and approval. Although final, the EPP is considered to be a living document that can be updated as required, should environmental conditions or circumstances change.
