RE: Doyles Quarry Expansion

Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental environmental assessment screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by Part X of the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act*, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Please be advised that this undertaking is **released** from further environmental assessment.

The Mineral Lands Division of the Department of Natural Resources advise that your project area has been reduced to a 0.98 hectare area, as shown in the attached diagram. The reduction of your proposed area is in response to private land that was identified within your project area during the environmental assessment of your project.

The Department of Fisheries and Land Resources advises that a Commercial Harvesting Permit is required prior to any harvesting or timber removal in the area. An Operating Permit is required prior to the start of any work during the forest fire season and can be obtained from the local forest management district office. During the forest fire season a permit to burn must be obtained to ignite a fire on or within 300 meters of forest land. For further information, please contact St. George's District Office, Forest Management District 13 and 14 at (709) 646-3720.

Although the undertaking, as proposed, is released from further environmental assessment, it is still subject to other legislative requirements. A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. Please note that you must comply with all relevant legislation and obtain all necessary permits and approvals. You are required to inform this Department of any proposed significant changes to the undertaking.
