RE: TCH near Glovertown Septic Waste Treatment Facility

Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental environmental assessment screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by Part X of the Newfoundland and Labrador *Environmental Protection Act*, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Please be advised that this undertaking is **released** from further environmental assessment.

The Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment advises that a Certificate of Approval is required from the Pollution Prevention Division (PPD) of the Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment, which will provide oversight for waste management and associated issues that may arise. For more information, please contact the Pollution Prevention Division at (709) 729-2556.

The Government Service Centre (GSC) of the Department of Service NL advises that you must submit and receive approval for certified engineering drawings and specifications for the proposed water and sewerage system. For further information, please contact the Gander Government Service Centre at (709) 256-1420.

The Department of Fisheries and Land Resources advises that a Commercial Harvesting Permit is required prior to any harvesting or timber removal in the area. An Operating Permit is required prior to the start of any work during the forest fire season and can be obtained from the local forest management district office. During the Forest Fire Season a permit to burn must be obtained to ignite a fire on or within 300 meters of forest land. For further information, please contact Gambo District Office, Forest Management District 4 and 5 at (709) 674-4625.

Although the undertaking, as proposed, is released from further environmental assessment, it is still subject to other legislative requirements. A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide an indication of likely applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. Please note that you must

comply with all relevant legislation and obtain all necessary permits and approvals. You are required to inform this Department of any proposed significant changes to the undertaking.
