Re: Come By Chance Delayed Coker Project

Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by the Newfoundland and Labrador Environmental Protection Act, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Upon consideration of the comments received, please be advised that an Environmental Preview Report (EPR) is required.

The EPR is necessary to provide information concerning the potential effects of the undertaking on the surrounding environment. Additional information requirements shall include, but are not limited to:

- Production rates, crude feedstocks, flow and management of products/by-products;
- Sulphur dioxide (SO₂) emission profile;
- New tanks and dyke construction details;
- Emission controls at the coke conveying and storage system;
- Greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions;
- Plans for gas turbines or internal combustion engines;
- Occupational information for construction and operations phase; and
- Effects on noise, water and air quality for nearby communities.

A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the registration review is attached to provide you with mitigative advice and to give you an indication of applicable permits, approvals and legislative requirements. The mitigative advice is provided for your information, consideration and inclusion in your project and in the EPR.

An Environmental Assessment Committee will be appointed for the purpose of providing you with technical and scientific advice regarding the preparation of an EPR. As per the legislative requirements, within 60 days of the date of this letter you will be issued guidelines for the completion of the EPR. Please be reminded that, in accordance with the Environmental Protection Act, project activities may not proceed until the proposal is released from the Environmental Assessment Process.
