RE: Waste Management Plan for Argentia Seafood Processing Plant

On November 19, 2021, the Argentia Seafood Processing Plants project was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. One condition of release required Dandy Dan's Fish Market Limited to submit a Waste Management Plan identifying comprehensive waste management practices for all liquid and solid waste, including the anticipated volumes. The condition also required the submission of any letters of agreement between you and the facilities accepting waste.

On November 14, 2022, you submitted a Waste Management Plan and a letter of confirmation from the Town of Sunnyside indicating that it can accept organic waste from your operation at the Sunnyside Waste Management Site. The Waste Management Plan was reviewed by the Pollution Prevention Division of my Department and found to be acceptable. I hereby approve the Waste Management Plan and advise that the condition of release has been satisfied.

You must abide by the commitments made in the Waste Management Plan, and any significant changes to the plan must be described to my Department to review for regulatory requirements, including environmental assessment.
