The Undertaking: (i) Nature of Undertaking

To include an additional area for domestic
harvesting in District 14.

(ii) Purpose/Rationale/Need for Undertaking

This undertaking will enable the Forest and Wildlife
Branch to schedule and issue domestic harvesting
permits for Long Point, Port au Port.

This undertaking is necessary to include these
additional areas for domestic harvest through the
duration of the Forest Management Districts 14 and
15 (Planning Zone 6) Five Year Operating Plan
2019-2023

Description of Undertaking: (i) Geographic Location

Long Point area of Port au Port and North of Tower Road. The overview map in the amendment outline the exact locations of the domestic block and represents approximately 38 hectares of productive forest.

(ii) Physical Features

The topography in the area ranges from lowlands to rolling uplands and mountain terrain.

(iii) Operation

Domestic harvesting will be done by chainsaw with extraction be snowmobile and ATV. All buffer requirements and operations will be carried out in accordance with the Environmental Protection Guidelines for Ecologically Based Forest Resource Management and the Forestry Act. Operations will commence upon approval of undertaking and continue yearly until 2025.

(iv) Occupants

Domestic Cutters.

Approval of the Undertaking:

Domestic cutting permits as well as operating permits will be required from the District Forest Management Office.

This amendment is scheduled to commence from date of approval and end on December 31, 2023.
