Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental environmental assessment screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public as required by Part X of the Newfoundland and Labrador **Environmental Protection Act**, SNL 2002, cE-14.2. Upon consideration of the comments received, please be advised that an Environmental Preview Report (EPR) is required.

The EPR is necessary to provide information concerning the potential effects of the undertaking on the surrounding environment. Additional information requirements include, but are not limited to:

- a description of the proposed alternative all-terrain vehicle (ATV) route;
- · details of construction methods; and
- location map(s) of proposed alternative route.

A summary of the comments received from government agencies during the review is attached to provide you with advice for your consideration and inclusion in your project design and in the EPR.

An Environmental Assessment Committee will be appointed for the purpose of providing you with technical and scientific advice regarding the preparation of the EPR. As per the legislative requirements, you will be issued guidelines for the completion of the EPR within 60 days of the date of this letter. Please be reminded that, in accordance with the **Environmental Protection Act**, project activities may not proceed until the undertaking is released from environmental assessment.
