**Re: Waste Management Plan for Green Bay Sawmill Production**

On June 1, 2022, the Green Bay Sawmill Production project was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. One condition of release required Green Bay Logging Limited to submit a Waste Management Plan that would identify the management of all potential waste streams, including spoilage, slabs, wood chips, and sawdust generated at the facility. The condition required the Waste Management Plan to include contingency plans to identify disposal options in the event that the waste streams cannot be fully utilized.

On July 14, 2022, you submitted a Waste Management Plan that was reviewed by the Pollution Prevention Division of my Department and found to be acceptable. I hereby approve the Waste Management Plan and advise that the condition of release requiring that plan in my decision letter of June 1, 2022, has been satisfied.

Please be further advised that you must abide by the commitments made in the Waste Management Plan, and any significant changes to the plan will be subject to additional review and approval.
