RE: Long Harbour River Outfitter Lodge Spike Camp (the Project) Environmental Protection Plan

On September 3, 2020, the Long Harbour River Outfitter Lodge Spike Camp Project was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. Two of these conditions required you to submit an Environmental Protection Plan (EPP) for review and approval by the Wildlife Division, Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture and to submit a digital GPS file of the access trail and camp location once established.

On March 15, 2023, Beaulieus Caribou Hunts 2005 Limited submitted an EPP and the GPS coordinates for review. I am advising you that the above documents were found to be acceptable by the Wildlife Division.

Please be advised that Beaulieus Caribou Hunts 2005 Limited must abide by all commitments made in the EPP and in all environmental assessment submissions. Any significant change to the EPP or to the Project must be submitted to my department prior to construction to be reviewed for regulatory requirements, including environmental assessment.
