	Municipal Approval: for proposed work that is within a municipal boundary, written
	confirmation is required indicating that the proposed work conforms with municipal
	zoning and that the work has been approved, approved conditionally, or that there are
	no objections to the proposed work before WRMD will issue a permit.
	Groundwater Requirements: for persons/companies/consultants developing un-
	serviced residential developments of more than 4 lots, written confirmation is required
	indicating that the undertaking has met all groundwater requirements before WRMD
	will issue a permit.
	Photos of the Site prior to work being undertaken.

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. <u>Indigenous Consultation:</u> If the application is for work in Labrador the proponent must check with the <u>Intergovernmental and Indigenous Affairs Secretariat</u> to determine if Indigenous Consultation is required, it is the responsibility of the proponent to undertake the consultation. Applications will be considered incomplete without the Indigenous Consultation.
- 2. Completed Applications Forms may take 4 to 6 weeks from the Date Received for Review and Processing.
- 3. If you wish to meet with someone regarding your application, appointments are required to be made a minimum of 24 hours in advance to ensure availability.
- 4. Please be advised that, in accordance with Government's Proactive Disclosure Initiative, your permit will be posted online subject to any exceptions to disclosure provided under the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, 2015.
