

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APPENDIX A
Terms and Conditions for Amendment

1. The total number of holes has been reduced from nine (9) to seven (7), with three (3) holes for the Sterling Deposit, and four (4) holes for the Twin Ponds Deposit. Revised coordinates have been provided for each of the holes. The locations of the revised holes for the Twin Ponds Deposit are indicated in the image in Appendix B.

2. The layout for the revised access route to the Twin Ponds Deposit has been changed to the route indicated by the white line in the image in Appendix B.
3. Condition 5 of the original Permit (PRO9430-2017) is relaxed to permit a 25 meter buffer zone to allow passage between wetlands identified in the field. This 25 meter reduced buffer would only be for the 90 meter section of the route between the points NAD83 Latitude 49° 31' 29.1" Longitude 56° 03' 45.7" and Latitude 49° 31' 27.2" Longitude 56° 03' 43.3" indicated in red in the image in appendix B, and will not be interpreted or applied anywhere else along the route.
4. All other operations, including access and drilling operations, are still subject to the minimum buffers of 50 meters for all ponds and streams and 30 meters for all wetlands (regardless of their size) as may be identified in the field, regardless of whether or not they are visible on mapping or other imagery. Access routes and drill sites shall be on dry, hard, stable ground.
5. In the event of any conflict or discrepancy between the conditions of the original Permit (PRO9430-2017), this Amendment, and Department of Natural Resources Exploration Approval E170319, the more stringent of the two shall apply.
6. Any subsequent changes proposed will require subsequent Amendments, fees and endorsements from the Town.
