**The original Permit dated JANUARY 28, 2019 is amended as follows:**

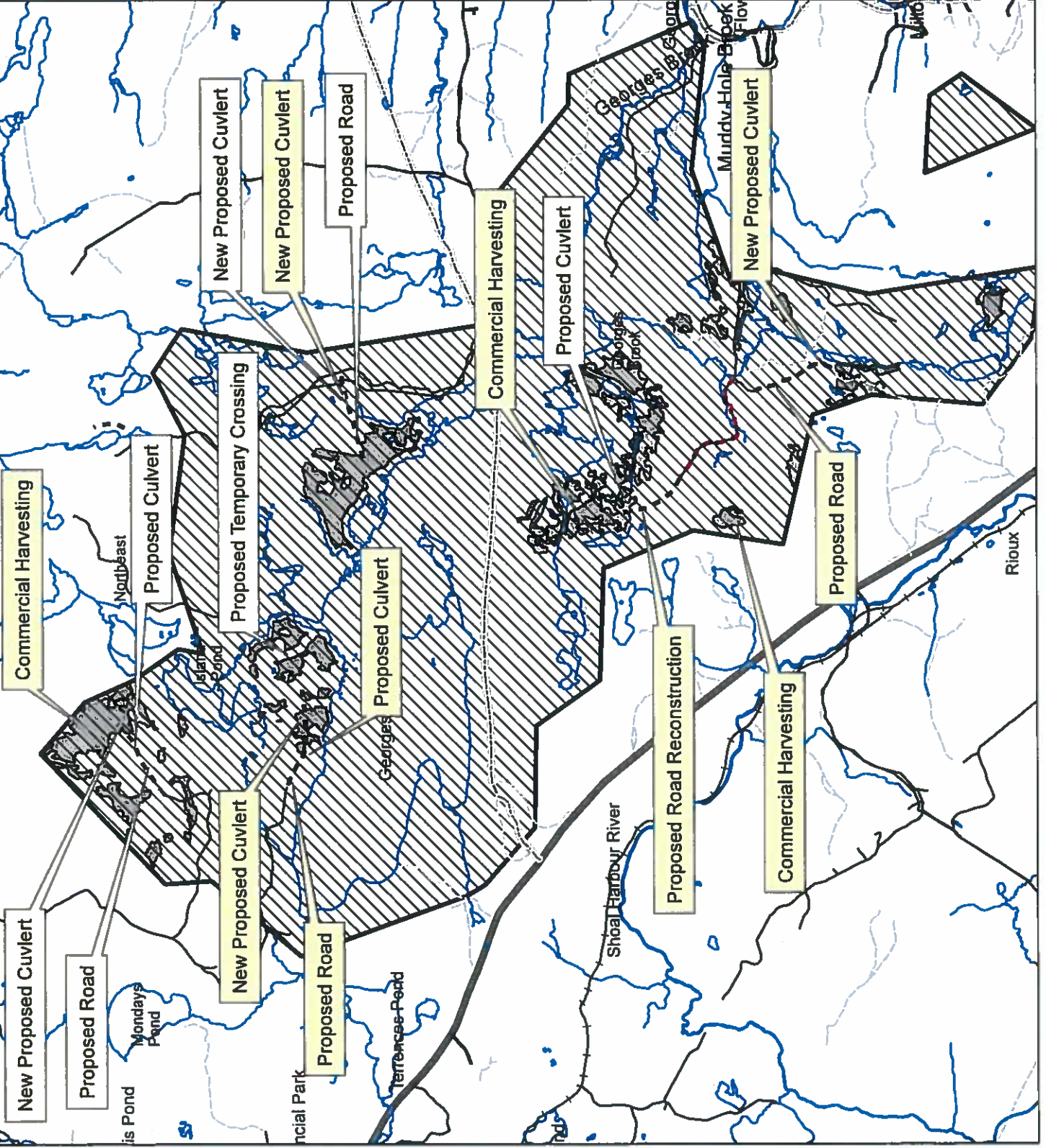
for the installation of five (5) additional culverts.
