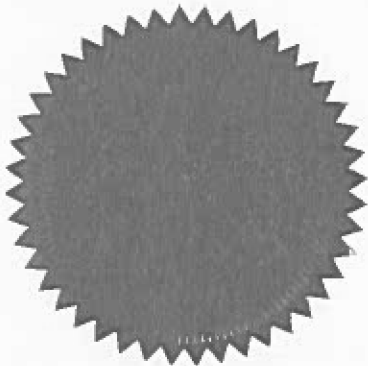


Re: **Indian Bay (Third Pond Brook) - Snowmobile Bridge Installation**

The original Permit dated NOVEMBER 21, 2012 is amended as follows:

The completion date for the installation of a bridge across Third Pond Brook on a relocated snowmobile trail between Gander and New-Wes-Valley within the Indian Bay Protected Water Supply Area, with reference to the application dated October 26, 2012 has been extended until December 31, 2016.

All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.
