
Re: **Lower Churchill Muskrat Falls - Dams, Powerhouse, Spillway and North Spur Stabilization**

The original Permit dated JULY 10, 2013 is amended as follows:

The construction of rollways in each spillway bay will commence in 2018 according to information received from Nalcor on Feb 28, 2018 and May 10, 2018 with the following conditions:

- No rollway construction shall take place from mid-April to mid-June during spring runoff.
- Any planned changes in the reservoir level will be communicated to the Water Resources Management Division.
- Any seepage through the stoplogs will be contained and discharged downstream. Any process water will be treated via Sedimentation Pond 1.
- The sequence for rollway construction shall be as follows: 1 and 5 first, 3 second, 2 and 4 third.
- During rollway construction, Muskrat Falls infrastructure must be able to pass the 1:20 year flow no matter what phase of construction.

All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.
