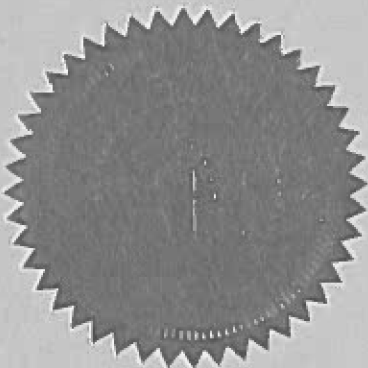


This Licence/Permit does not release the Licensee/Holder from the obligation to obtain appropriate approvals or permits from other concerned municipal, provincial and federal agencies.

It should be noted that prior approval of any significant change(s) in the plans and/or the associated systems and works must be obtained from the Minister.

The Licensee/Holder shall complete and return the attached Notification of Acceptance of Marine Aquaculture Water Use Licence/Permit (attached) to the Water Rights and Investigations Section of the Department of Environment and Climate Change within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Licence/Permit.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions set out herein will render this Licence/Permit null and void, place the Licensee/Holder and/or its agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act*, and cause the Licensee/Holder to be responsible for any and all remedial measures which may be prescribed by the Department of Environment and Climate Change.

APPENDIX A
TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MARINE AQUACULTURE WATER USE LICENCE/PERMIT

The Minister of Environment and Climate Change (the "Minister") hereby grants a non-exclusive water right to: **Northern Harvest Sea Farms Newfoundland Ltd.** (the "Licensee/Holder") to operate an existing aquaculture facility with an estimated area of 5.0 hectares in Strickland Cove, Little Passage, Bay D'Espoir (47°39'36"N, 55°56'20"W) in reference to the plans submitted with the original application received on May 15, 2006 and the request and further information provided by the Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agrifoods on or before September 29, 2016.

1. The designated purpose of the water use is Commercial/Aquaculture.
2. The Licensee/Holder shall not impair, pollute or cause to be polluted the quality of the water.
3. The Licensee/Holder shall secure the aquaculture gear by suitable anchors to prevent dislodgement due to wave action and clearly mark the perimeter of the facility with cautionary buoys.
4. The Licensee/Holder shall immediately notify the Minister if any problem arises which may adversely affect water or public safety or any and all water users. The Licensee/Holder shall be responsible for any environmental or property damage, or personal injury arising from dislodgement caused by wind, wave, or ice action, or structural failure or from other water related problems.
5. In the event that the site is no longer being used during the term created by this Licence/Permit, the Licensee/Holder shall remove the aquaculture gear and other work(s)/system(s) associated with and restore all areas affected by this facility to a state that resembles local natural conditions. Further remedial measures to mitigate environmental impacts on water resources and all areas affected by this facility can and will be specified, if necessary in the opinion of this Department.
6. The Licensee/Holder acknowledges and agrees that this Licence/Permit does not grant any interest in land or any right to construct onshore facilities.
7. The Licensee/Holder agrees to abide by such further terms and conditions and directives as may be issued by the Minister of Environment and Climate Change from time to time in relation to the site referenced in this Licence/Permit.
8. Ownership of water rights remains with the Crown and is not transferred. The Licence/Permit only provides permission for the Licensee/Holder to use water for the purpose indicated herein. The rights and liberties granted by this Licence/Permit may only be sold, assigned, transferred, leased, mortgaged, sublet or otherwise given away by the Licensee/Holder by obtaining prior written approval from the Minister of Environment and Climate Change.
9. This Licence/Permit shall remain in force and effect until such time as the Aquaculture Licence of the Licensee/Holder is not renewed by the Licensee/Holder or is cancelled by the Minister of Fisheries, Forestry and Agrifoods of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador or his successor in office pursuant to the provisions of the Aquaculture Act, RSN 1990, c.A-13 or until such time as it is revoked by the Minister of Environment and Climate Change of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador or his successor in office for failure to comply with one or more of the provisions of this Licence/Permit (as amended from time to time) or with the provisions of the Water Resources Act, SNL 2002 c.W-4.01 and any regulations in effect thereunder from time to time and any other relevant legislation enacted by the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador in the future.
10. The Licensee/Holder indemnifies and holds the Minister and Government harmless against any and all liabilities, losses, claims, demands, damages or expenses including legal expenses of any nature whatsoever whether arising in tort, contract, statute, trust or otherwise resulting directly or indirectly from the water rights granted under this Licence/Permit, systems and works associated with this aquaculture facility, or any act or omission of the Licensee/Holder in or from and systems and works associated with this aquaculture facility, or arising out of a breach or non-performance of any of the terms and conditions, and provisions of this Licence/Permit by the Licensee/Holder.
11. This Licence/Permit supercedes and cancels in whole and in part Marine Aquaculture Water Use Licence/Permit No. WUL-06-065 issued on July 27, 2006.
