The Department is looking for communities currently on a BWA to become active participants in this 2018-19 BWA Reduction Initiative. Through this initiative, additional supports and guidance will be provided to interested communities. Involvement of your community may require attending a short workshop, as well as one-on-one coaching with the Department and an external consultant acting on behalf of the Department. Involvement may also require communities to secure capital works funding through existing cost-share mechanisms to finance any required infrastructure upgrades. The goal of this initiative is to implement appropriate corrective measures for your community's public drinking water system, and to have your BWA lifted.
