RE: Glover Island ATV Trail (the Project)

Your proposal has been reviewed by an interdepartmental environmental assessment screening committee and an opportunity to comment has been provided to the public required by Part X of the Newfoundland and Labrador **Environmental Protection Act, SNL 2002, cE-14.2**. Upon consideration of the comments received, please be advised that an Environmental Preview Report (EPR) is required.

The EPR is necessary to inform the significance of the potential effects of the undertaking on the surrounding environment, and to explore the effects of alternatives. These additional information requirements will be provided to you by my officials in the coming days.

An Environmental Assessment Committee (EAC) will be appointed for the purpose of providing you with technical and scientific advice regarding the preparation of the EPR. The EAC will provide you with guidelines to assist you in developing the EPR. Once submitted, the EPR will be subject to a 35-day review by the EAC and the public, and I will provide you with a decision on the EPR within 10 days of the completion of this review.

In accordance with the **Environmental Protection Act**, the Project activities may not proceed until the undertaking is released from environmental assessment. Your undertaking may be subject to environmental assessment fees as described in the Environmental Assessment Fees Policy located at Fees for Environmental Assessment - Environment and Climate Change (gov.nl.ca). Please review the fees policy and submit



a capital cost estimate for the undertaking to EAProjectComments@gov.nl.ca within two weeks of receiving this letter.
