The Honourable Chris Tibbs, Minister of Environment, Conservation and Climate Change, has announced the following relative to Environmental Assessment - Part 10 - of the **Environmental Protection Act**.

Undertaking Registered:

Holyrood Shingle Recycling Facility (Reg. 2391)
Proponent: Black Rock Construction Group/ 86790 Newfoundland & Labrador Limited

The proponent is proposing to develop an asphalt shingle recycling facility at 49 Horizon Drive in Holyrood. Construction would include site clearing, grading, paving, and installation of equipment including a grinder, asphalt recycler, truck scales and a scale house. The undertaking was registered on February 26, 2026. The deadline for public comment is April 3, 2026, and the minister's decision is due by April 12, 2026.
