**RE: CBPPL Zone 5, District 10 Five-Year Forestry Operating Plan (2026-2030)
(the Project) Tourism Stakeholder Consultation Plan and Erosion and
Sediment Control Plan**

On September 8, 2025, the Project was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. Two of the conditions of release required Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited to submit a Tourism Stakeholder Consultation Plan and an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan.

On December 1, 2025, Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited submitted the Tourism Stakeholder Consultation Plan to the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts and Recreation. On December 10, 2025, Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited submitted the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan to the Water Resources Management Division of my department. I am advising you that these plans have been reviewed and accepted.

You must abide by all commitments made in the Tourism Stakeholder Consultation Plan and Erosion and Sediment Control Plan and in all environmental assessment submissions. Any significant change to these plans or to the Project must be submitted to this department prior to construction, to be reviewed for regulatory requirements including environmental assessment.

You must also comply with all terms and conditions of the September 8, 2025, decision letter including the requirement to prepare and submit a Greenhouse Gas Management Plan for my approval. An update on the progress of the plan is to be submitted by March 8, 2026, and a draft of this plan shall be submitted by September 8, 2026.
