




**WATER CROSSING PROTECTION PLAN**  
**Little Gull River and Cat Brook Resource Road**  
**March 5, 2026**

Appendix A, Section 5 of the Environmental Assessment (EA 2385) requires the proponent to complete a Water Crossing Protection Plan to be approved by the Water Resource Management Division of the Department of Environment, Conservation and Climate Change prior to construction and land clearing. The Plan requires the Permit Holder / Land Holder and the Contractor to comply with the following conditions:

1. There shall be **no** bulk fuel storage within **150 meters** of Cat Brook or Little Gull River.
2. Equipment storage, maintenance, or refueling shall **not** take place within **150 meters** of Cat Brook or Little Gull River
3. When being used within **30 meters** of Cat Brook or Little Gull River, fuel powered equipment must be visually inspected **hourly** to ensure there is no leaking fuel or fluids.
4. Any spills of fuel or oil, regardless of volume, within **150 meters** of Cat Brook or Little Gull River shall be reported **immediately** to the Water Resources Management Division at (709) 292-4280 or [waterinvestigations@gov.nl.ca](mailto:waterinvestigations@gov.nl.ca).

It is agreed by all parties, that the work being completed as part of the Little Gull River and Cat Brook Resource road (EA 2385) will comply with the requirements of the Water Crossing Protection Plan as specified herein.
