RE: Indian River Quarry Extension (the Project) Water Resources Management

On May 21, 2026, the Project was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. One of the conditions required J & J Paving Ltd. to submit a Water Resources Management Plan (the Plan) prior to commencing any work related to the Project.

On June 4, 2026, J & J Paving Ltd. submitted the Plan to the Water Resources Management Division of this department. This Plan has now been reviewed and accepted.

You are reminded that you must abide by all commitments made in the Plan and in all environmental assessment submissions. You must also comply with all terms and conditions of the May 21, 2026, decision letter including the following requirements by the Wildlife Division of the Department of Forestry, Agriculture and Lands, to be completed prior to Project construction:

- Conduct a pre-clearing survey of all trees and snags with a diameter at breast height of greater than 25 centimetres for potential active bat colonies, should tree removal be necessary from May 1 to September 1.
- Engage with the Wildlife Division regarding potential surveys and appropriate mitigations for bank swallow to prevent disturbance, injury, or direct loss of swallows or their residences.
- Conduct a Black Ash survey on the Project site and present the results to the Wildlife Division.

Any significant change to the Plan or to the Project must be submitted to this department prior to construction, to be reviewed for regulatory requirements including environmental assessment.
