Geographical Location :

George's Brook- Old Dump Road, 2.57km W of Route 230A and 1.5km East of Route 230 (Bonavista Hyw)

Please see attached map for physical location. We chose this location because it was previously used has a Quarry.

Physical Features:

This site was already an old quarry , we are using the same 1.3 Hectares as original quarry . The main Road and Road to quarry is in place, with no encroaching on other quarry operations. There are no plans for buildings or any permanent stuctures. The area is free of powerlines and there is no related infrastructure . There is no old growth trees in this location. we will be taking off the top layer of ground cover this includes alders , small trees , grass. No running water or brooks on site, one small standing pool . The only infrastructure present is the Road itself, Transmission Line is 2-3 km away to the south east and 1-2 km to the north east is route 230. There is no visable wildlife to be seen on the site.

Construction:

The project shall include the clearing the grubbing and topsoil to be stockpiled on site for rehabilitation purposes. The operation will take place on the 1.3 hectares in the Fall of 2026. We will start with two people using a modle year 2025 excavator and a 2016 Dump Truck. We anticipate operating phase for our project to be 20 years. Potential contaminants include coolants, motor and fuel oils, hydraulic oils all our equipment are operating with the DEF systems, to ensure the lowest possible emissions. Spill kits and Fire protection in all equipment Training will be provided to all employees in prevention and mitigation for their own safety and safety of the wildlife and environment.

Operation:

We anticipated operations phase for aggregate such as(Pit Run &Class B) starting September 2026 and continuing for the life of the pit. we will be using a excavator and dump truck, at this time there is no plan for crushing or screening.Potential contaminants include coolants, motor and fuel oils, hydraulic oils . Equipment used will be inspected every day and maintenance done regularly and spill containment will be on site along with Fire protection and first aid equipment to ensure safety of the people and environment.

Occupations:
