- 6 levels of French

Schedule

- Monday to Friday:
 - AM: French classes (pronunciation, conversation, grammar) and Quebec's culture or Tourism classes
 - PM: workshops, well-being activities, Explore Québec outings and free time.
 - Evenings: special activities (shows, movies, etc.), free optional activities on campus and free time
- Weekends:
 - Optional excursions (extra cost)
 - Free time
 - Free optional activities on campus



- Single or double rooms
