

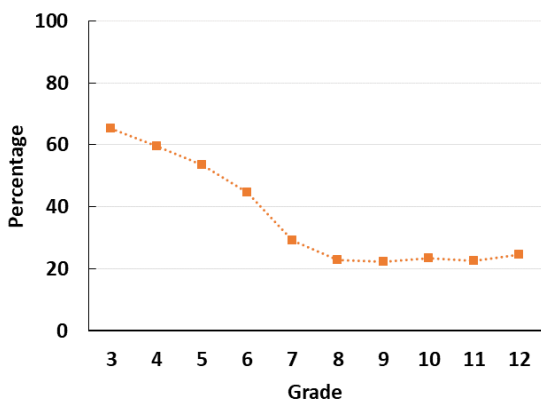

What percentage of student respondents report being engaged?



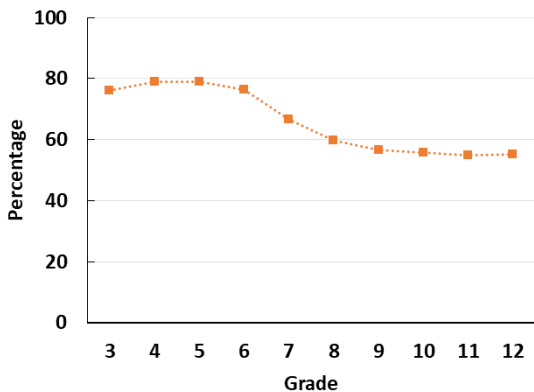
37% in grades 3 to 12

What percentage of student respondents believe that teachers hold them to high expectations?



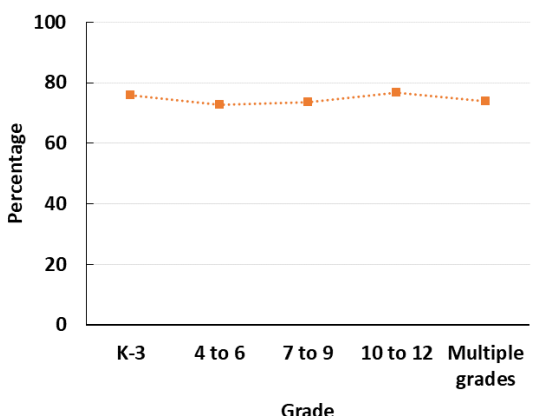
67% in grades 3 to 12

What percentage of teacher respondents report being confident in their teaching?

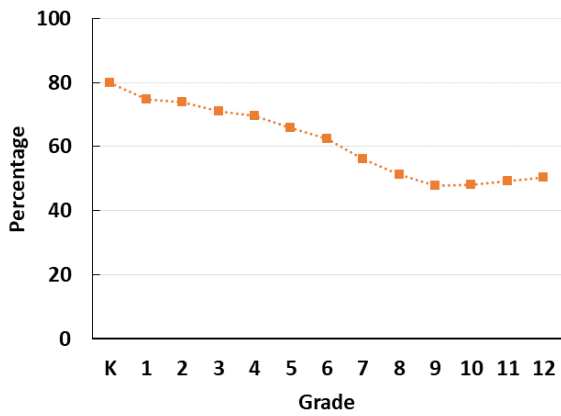

### Data Collection Methodology

The data is collected using the School Development Surveys completed by students (Gr. 3-12), families, instructional staff, and non-instructional staff.

**Response Rates:** Gr. 3-6: 86% Gr. 7-9: 73% Gr. 10-12: 64% Instructional Staff: 80%\* Family: 25%^

\*The response rate for non-instructional staff is not available.

^Families with more than one child in a school may complete the survey once for the oldest child in that school.
