- Contain age-appropriate level of French language and vocabulary for primary, French Immersion (not French first language) students
- A digital pdf version of successful titles, if available, will be requested for alternate format materials (AFM) purposes
- Resource(s) must be in an accessible format that is compatible with assistive technology
- Estimated quantities required of successful titles of resources are a minimum of 120
- Available digitally and in hard copy (printable)
