

#### What percentage of student respondents reported a positive school climate?



# What percentage of teacher respondents reported a positive school climate?



# What percentage of family respondents reported a positive school climate?





# What percentage of family respondents reported a safe school environment?







#### **Data Collection Methodology**

The data is collected using the School Development Surveys completed by students (Gr. 3-12), families, instructional staff, and non-instructional staff.

**Response Rates:** Gr. 3-6: 84% Gr. 7-9: 72% Gr. 10-12: 56% Instructional Staff: 67%\* Family: 22%^

^Families with more than one child in a school may complete the survey once for the oldest child in that school.
