Technology Instructions

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Instructions for Install Sonar Home Studio

1. Insert the Sonar Home Studio Install Disk into your CDROM drive.
2. The installer will start automatically. Once the installer has started click “Install.”
3. Click “Sonar Home Studio.”
4. In the “Multi-Language Installer” window select “U.S. English.”
5. You will be asked to exit all Windows programs before you proceed. After doing so you need to click “Next.”
6. In the “Software License Agreement” window, after reading the agreement, place a check in the box marked “I understand that I can install and use this software on only one machine at a time.” Next place a check next to “I understand that I cannot transfer or sell this software. Next click on the radio button marked “I accept the terms of the License Agreement.” Click the “Next” button.
7. In the “Privacy Policy” window click the “Next” button.
8. Next you will see the “Get Registration” window. In the “Name” window enter your name. In the “Company” window enter the name of your school. In the Serial Number window enter the serial number for Sonar. You can find the serial number on the paper sleeve for the Sonar installation CD. Click the “Next” button.
9. In the “Select Components” window do not change anything. Click the “Next” button.
10. In the “Destinations Folder” window do not change anything. Click the “Next” button.
11. In the “Select Shared Plug-ins Folder” window do not change anything. Click the “Next” button.
12. In the “Select Program Manager Group” window do not change anything. Click the “Next” button.
13. In the “Start Installation” window click the “Next” button.
14. Do not do anything with the computer while Sonar Home Studio installs.
15. In the “Associate File with the Application” window do not change anything. Click the “Next” button.
16. In the “Register VST Plug-ins” window select “No...” and click the “Next” button.
17. In the “Optional Installations” window remove any check boxes and click the “Next” button.
18. In the “Installation Complete” window select your options and click Finish.
19. Run Sonar Home Studio.
20. The first time you run Sonar Home Studio you will be given the “Wave Profiler” window – select “Yes.”
21. When the “Wave Profiler” test is complete you can click “Close.”

22. Next you will be given the “Complete Registration” window. In the “Registration Code” window follow the instructions and you will receive your registration code by email. Once you have received your code enter it into this window and click “Complete.”
23. Close the “Tips” window.
24. In the “No Midi Outputs Selected” window select “Continue with no MIDI Output.”

Once Sonar is installed you need to make one setting change to insure the sound will work on your computer.

1. Start up Sonar
2. Under the “Options” menu and go to “Audio.”
3. Click the “Advanced” tab
4. In the “Driver Mode” setting choose “MME (32 bit).”
5. Restart Sonar

Sonar Home Studio is now ready to use.

Installation Guide for Music Ace Maestro

1. Insert the Music Ace CD into the CDROM
2. Click “Setup Music Ace Maestro”
3. You will be given a window asking to close all programs before installing. After doing this you need to click the “Next” button.
4. After reading the License Agreement you need to click “Yes.”
5. In the User Information window enter Joan House for the User Name and CDLI for the Institution then click “Next.”
6. You will be asked for your registration code. This 16-digit code is found in the box Music Ace was shipped in. Once you have entered the registration number click “Next.”
7. Put a check box in for “Database Manager” and click “Next.”
8. You will be asked to choose a destination location for all the Music Ace files. You should keep the default location, but if you like you can choose a different location. Once you are satisfied you can click “Next.”
9. You will asked if you want Music Ace to “Auto-Login.” Select “no” and click “Next.”
10. In the “Select Program Folder” window leave the default settings and click “Next.”
11. Once Music Ace has completed the installation you can click “Finish.”

Now Music Ace is installed on your computer.
