What is AFMNL?

A library which provides online and off-line alternate format materials to students who are unable to use traditional print materials.

Students with disabilities related to manipulating, seeing or reading text, or teachers working with these students, are eligible to access AFMNL.

Who are AFM Advisors?

Each school has one or more AFM Advisors. AFM Advisors:

Have access to a list of all students in their school currently approved for AFMNL.

Can reset student passwords.

Can add AFM resources to a students account.
