

APPENDIX – Music

Student Tutor Books

Tutor books should be ordered by schools. These resource materials are eligible for a one-time 100% reimbursement, based on an allotment of \$20.00 per student, per course/method level. For subsequent years, school programs will be provided with a 10% replacement, based on the initial implementation amount. As with other authorized resources, 100% reimbursement will only apply to match increased enrollment numbers and course levels/methods, at an allotment of \$20.00 per student. The 100% reimbursement is also applicable to those school program sites that have yet to avail of this opportunity. Only tutor books from the authorized listing above will be considered eligible for reimbursement
