26.0	103.6	GREENSTONE: Fine grained, green, slightly chloritized, locally silicified, numerous narrow irregular quartz, feldspar, epidote stringers, few scattered grains of pyrite, zones of slightly coarser grain. Occasional bands of amygdalites. 73.0 - 92.5' Slightly sheared (30°).
103.6	115.0	GRANITE FOREBURN DIKE: Fine to medium grained, grey to pink, with feldspar and minor quartz phenocrysts, occasional specks of chlorite, minor pyrite.
115.0	294.6	GREENSTONE: Fine grained, green, slightly sheared (50°) with minor chlorite development, numerous quartz, feldspar and epidote stringers and minor carbonate blebs. A few small scattered blebs of pyrite after 200'.
294.6	303.0	JASPER: Very fine grained, red, with considerable injected quartz, minor magnetite. Hole caved at 270', cemented. Rods stuck in drilling cement lost 130'. END OF HOLE
