14.0	209.0	Highly siliceous diabase unsheared and unmineralized.
209.0	333.0	Not so siliceous as above.
333.0	334.0	Coarser unaltered unmineralized diabase.
334.0	511.0	Hanging-wall diabase schisted in places and with a little quartz occasionally.
511.0		Beginning of shear zone.
511.0	580.0	Pyritically mineralized, sheared diabase, siliceous. No chalcopryite.
580.0	664.0	Sheared diabase pyrrhotite, pyrite and traces of chalcopryite.
664.0	684.0	Very heavy in pyrite. Sheared diabase.
684.0	693.0	Sheared diabase with pyrite, pyrrhotite and traces of chalcopryite.
693.0	753.0	Siliceous sheared diabase with pyrite, pyrrhotite and fairly good spots of chalcopryite. No ore.
753.0	778.0	Fine-grained dike.
778.0	799.0	Siliceous diabase with spots of chalcopryite, some pyrrhotite and pyrite.
799.0	922.0	Heavily pyritically mineralized sheared diabase, siliceous in places; no chalcopryite.
922.0	911.0	Highly siliceous, sheared diabase, mineralized with pyrite and small amounts of pyrrhotite and chalcopryite.
911.0	916.0	Fine grained dike.
916.0	1267.0	Pyritically mineralized sheared diabase. A small sign of copper at 1158 feet.

Hole started: June 7, 1923.

This hole was put down between holes 1 and 2 and failed to locate ore. It appears from this hole that the Gull Pond Ore body is in the form of a pitching lense.
