65.0	90.0	Altered cherty lava or tuff. Fairly abundant pyrite, No pyrrhotite except clusters at 78, 81.5, and 82.5. No chalcopryite except scant at 78 and 81.5 and 82.5.
90.0	110.0	Altered andesitic lava. Fairly abundant to scant pyrite, no pyrrhotite except dense clusters at 95.
110.0	174.0	Altered cherty lava or tuff. Very scant pyrite.
174.0	192.0	Strongly altered andesitic lava. Scant to fairly abundant pyrite.
192.0	202.0	Cherty lava or tuff. Very scant pyrite.
202.0	209.0	Sheared altered cherty lava or tuff. Fairly abundant to scant pyrite.
209.0	214.0	Strongly altered andesitic and cherty lavas. Abundant pyrite.
214.0	219.0	Strongly altered andesitic and cherty lavas. Abundant to fairly abundant pyrite and fairly abundant pyrrhotite.
219.0	222.0	Strongly altered andesitic lava. Very abundant pyrite, fairly abundant pyrrhotite and fairly abundant to scant chalcopryite.
222.0	224.0	Strongly altered cherty lava or tuff. Abundant pyrite, Very scant pyrrhotite and chalcopryite.
224.0	259.0	Altered andesitic lava. Abundant to fairly abundant pyrite.
259.0	260.0	Highly altered andesitic lava. Abundant pyrite, scant pyrrhotite and very scant chalcopryite.
260.0	310.0	Altered cherty lava or tuff. Abundant to fairly abundant pyrite, no pyrrhotite except at 283 to 284 fairly abundant.
310.0	333.0	Andesitic lava. Fairly abundant to scant pyrite.
